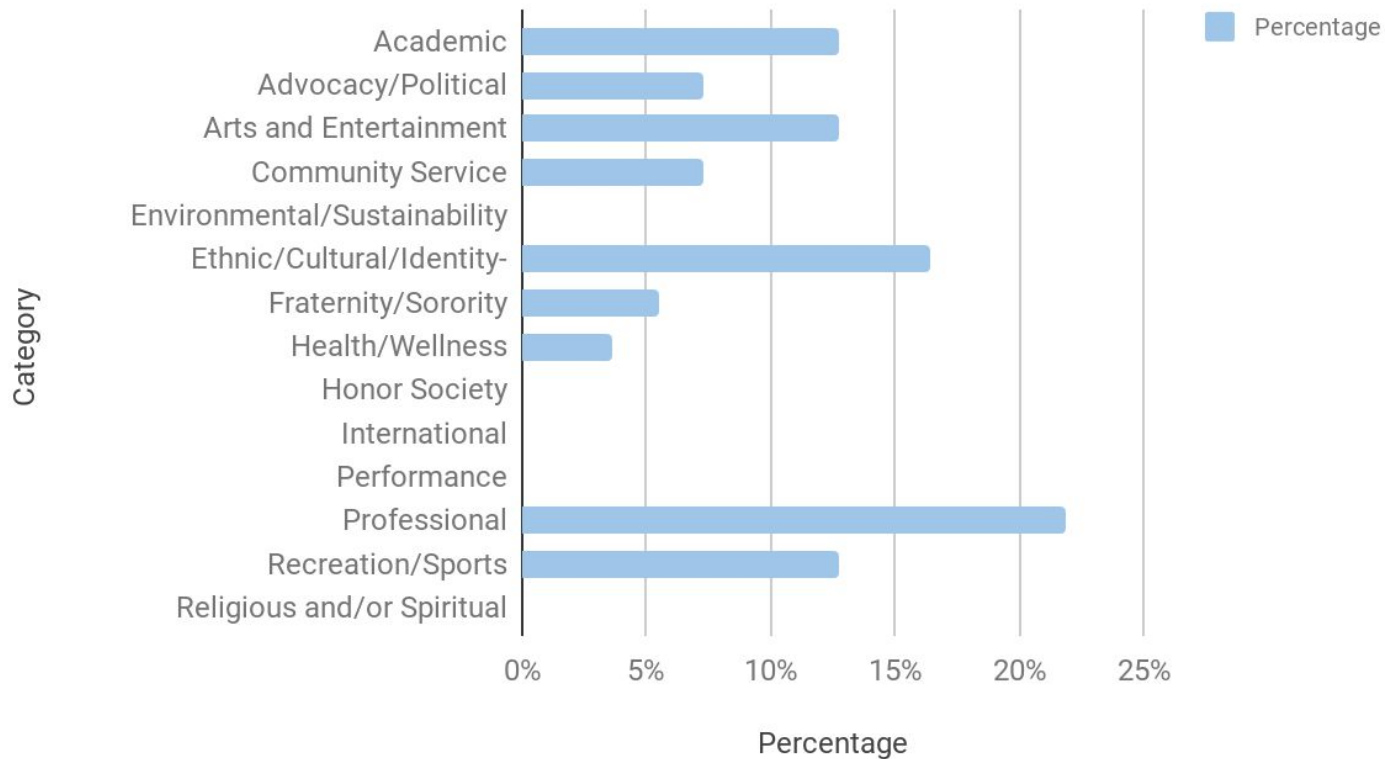

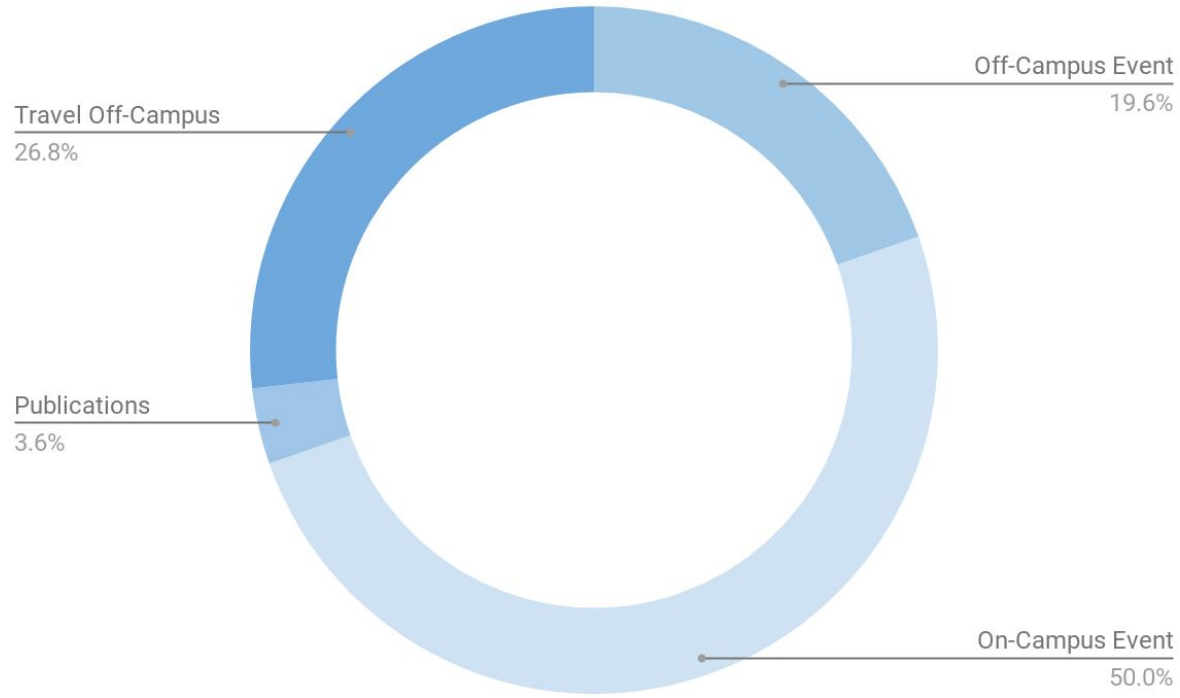


Winter Allocation Decisions

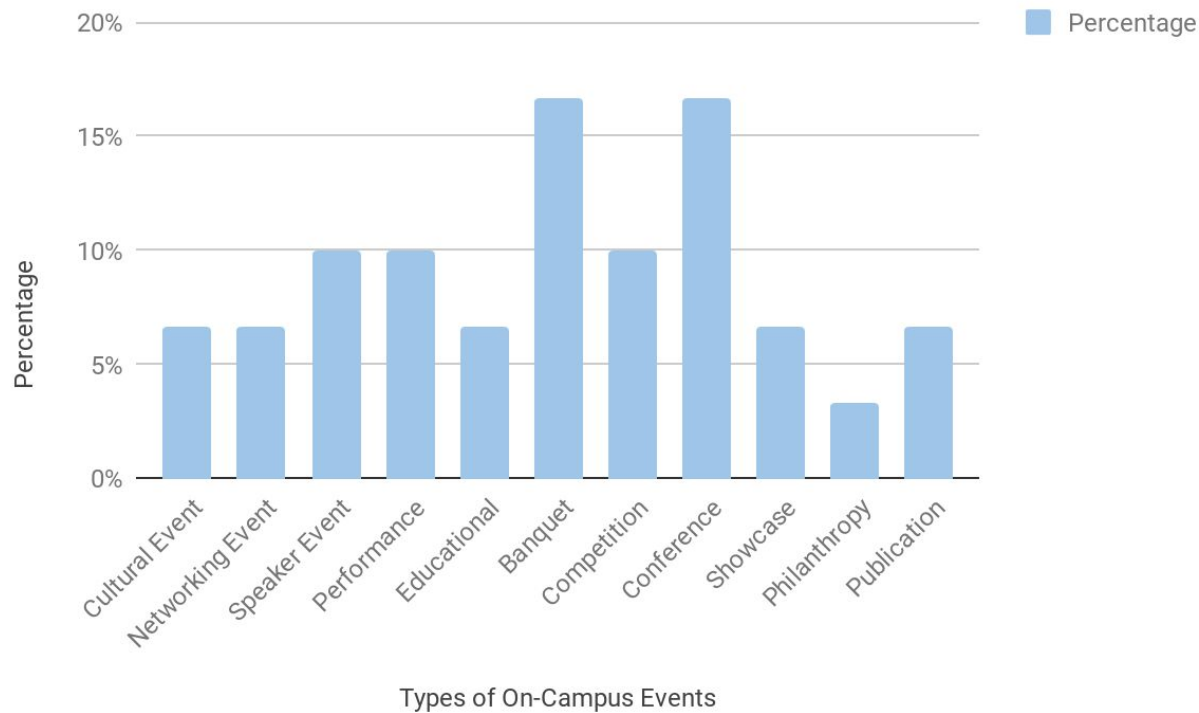
Types of RSOs Applied
